Sample Itinerary:

Day 1 - Fly non-stop to Seattle. Dinner included tonight. Lodging at Hampton Inn Downtown.

Day 2 - A sightseeing tour of Seattle highlights our morning. Visit Pike Place Market, considered Seattle's heart and soul. This afternoon visit Mt. St. Helen's Visitor Center. The Center features walk through interpretive exhibits and award-winning theatre programs. to educate the visitor on the tale of events that lead to the 1980 eruption. Arrive in Portland, the "City of Roses" for (2) nights. Lodging at Holiday Inn Express East Portland.

Day 3 - Visit Timberline Lodge, famous as the setting in the movie The Shining, situated on the vast slopes of 11,290-foot Mt. Hood. Ride the chair lift high up the mountain flank. Take a tour of the lodge and enjoy an included lunch high up in the mountains. Proceed down the scenic Hood River Valley to the Columbia River and the Bonneville Dam and Lock. See the salmon ladders and learn about the impressive lock system. Our last stop is Multnomah Falls, a waterfall as magnificent as any in the country. At 611 feet, the roaring cascade of water allows you to experience the power and beauty of nature up close. Dinner included tonight.

Day 4 - Oregon has over 200 state parks, most of which are along the dramatic coast. Oregon's coastline is made up of diverse terrain that changes from rugged cliffs to evergreen forests to Sahara-like dunes to boundless sandy beaches. Traveling south we'll pass breathtaking coastal scenery, scores of quaint towns, historic lighthouses and stunning viewpoints. Arrive in Newport, Oregon for a mid-day whale watching cruise. See the massive Gray whale which reach 45 feet in length, the same as our motorcoach. Check into the Hallmark Resort, a 1st class oceanfront hotel. Your guest room overlooks the Pacific Ocean. (www.hallmarkinns.com) Dinner included.

Day 5 - What a perfect setting to enjoy a morning at your leisure. This magnificent oceanfront resort overlooks the expansive Pacific Ocean with Yaquina Lighthouse to the north. Stunning sunrises and sunsets, the coming and going of fishing fleets, and the occasional whale sighting, are all within view. An optional visit to the Oregon Coast Aquarium is available. This afternoon visit Oregon Sand Dunes, some of which reach heights of 300 feet. Enjoy a thrilling dune buggy ride an exciting tour that takes us over the dunes and also takes us on a leisurely ride right on the beach of the Pacific Ocean. Stop at Heceta Head Lighthouse, which was built in 1894 and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. From a height of 205 feet above the ocean, it casts it's beam 21 miles out to sea. Located right on the coast, it is one of the most photographed lighthouses in the United States. We're back at the Hallmark Inn for our second night. This spectacular oceanfront hotel will be a tour highlight.

Day 6 - Continue to Grant's Pass, Oregon home of the incredible Hellgate Canyon Jetboat Tour. Our hotel is the Riverside Inn located right on the Rogue River. Late afternoon board the Rogue River Hellgate Canyon Jetboat Tour for a thrilling excursion through this breathtaking canyon. Close-ups of the remarkable rock formations carved by the river's hydraulics will fascinate you. See the canyon where John Wayne and Katherine Hepburn filmed "Rooster Cogburn". This trip is also a dinner excursion as we stop for a "Country Banquet" at the OK Coral, an old homestead down river. (www.hellgate.com)

Day 7 - Continue south into California along the stunning coastal route to Redwood National Park. To someone who has never seen one, a Redwood must seem to be something from a tall tale. See trees taller than the Statue of Liberty and larger around than a motorcoach. Hop aboard the "Sky Gondola" for a once-in-a-lifetime gondola ride through "The Trees of Mystery". Overnight in Eureka, California.

Day 8 - En route to San Francisco stop in Pepperwood and explore the "Avenue of the Giants". Walk among these giant redwoods, where some visitors envision dinosaurs rumbling through the forests in bygone eras. Travel through the stunning Sonoma Valley into scenic wine country and stop at a local winery. Our last (2) nights are in San Francisco at the Holiday Inn Express-Fishermen's Wharf. Perfectly positioned in the heart of the Wharf district, the hotel offers tastefully appointed guest rooms along with the excellent location in the midst of the bustling waterfront area.

Day 9 - Explore one of the world's most amazing cities on a morning sightseeing tour . The afternoon is at your leisure. A group farewell dinner concludes our day.

Day 10 - Fly home non-stop from San Francisco back to Detroit as our Oregon Coast tour concludes.
